What would you do without your electronic devices—phones, tablets and laptops—the list is endless.

But when you inevitably upgrade, what happens to the discards?

Sadly, the majority end up in the landfill, polluting our coasts, oceans and cities. In 2016, the EPA estimates that in the United States, 53 percent of consumer electronics ended up in the landfill.

Our planet's finite resources are being stretched to breaking point. For Goodwill, sustainability of people and planet is at the core of our mission to do good in the communities we serve. **Goodwill gives reusable items a Second Life and people a Second Chance.**

For instance, in 2017 Goodwill of San Francisco, San Mateo and Marin <u>diverted 23 million pounds</u> <u>from the local landfill</u>, largely through recycling textiles and refurbishing computers and electronics.

I'm proud to share that by this summer, 60% of our vehicle fleet will be electric, reducing carbon emissions in the neighborhoods we serve and preparing our drivers for transitions in the transportation industry.

Our impact is profound—creating equity through employment for people who are struggling to gain a foothold in the economy and making our community a safer and healthier place to live.
